Abstract Submissions

- One 8 ½ x 11 page
- Single spaced
- Size 12 font (either Times New Roman or Arial).
- List all authors with primary presenter first.

Oral presentations are 15-45 minutes in length followed by a 5 minute question and answer session. Submissions will be reviewed and the final length of presentations will be determined by the NPCNA committee.

Presentation Proposal Requirements

- Title
- Purpose of project or problem
- Two objectives
- Review of literature
- Evaluation
- Concise summary of content, outcomes and implications for pediatric nursing.

Submission Deadlines

Note: Conflict of Interest Disclosure and at least one reference must be provided with initial submission. Submission material will not be reviewed or considered if not accompanied by both.

Oral abstract: April 1, 2017. Acceptance notices will be sent via email in mid May.

Poster Presentation: May 15, 2017. Acceptance notices will be sent via email in mid-June.
